- Zip up/fabric binder (3 in. minimum)
- 1 small plastic pencil-supply box (size around 2 ½ in. x 8 ½ in. x 5 in. -no room for large size)
- 1 10-pack clear **top loading** protector sheets with three-holes
- 7 **plastic** subject dividers with write on tabs (not tear off/insert paper tabs) with 3 holes
- Zippered pencil pouch that fits in binder with 3-metal reinforced holes
- 8 plastic (so will last) pocket folders with 3 holes (One of each color: yellow, purple, pink, green, orange, blue, red, and black)
- 1 pack **thin** yellow highlighters
- 1 24-count crayons
- Crayola washable markers – 8 count
- 2 packages #2 pencils
- 2 packages (**0.7 lead only**) mechanical pencils
- 2 packages **0.7** lead
- 1 package colored pencils
- 2 package (minimum 8-pack) red pens
- large-size packages of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 5-1 subject spiral notebooks (**no large 3-subject size**) with following colors: green, orange, blue, yellow, pink
- 1 package of pencil-top erasers
- 1 pair of pointed scissors that cut well
- glue sticks
- 1 large box of Kleenex tissues
- 1 package 3x5 lined 100 count index cards
- 1 **pocket size** paperback dictionary/thesaurus
- 1 orange 3-ring 1 in. thick binder
- 1 package of large project-size poster board
- 1 Bible (N.I.V. preferred)
- 1 set of headphones in a Zip-lock baggie with name written on it
- Inexpensive flash drive available (keep at home until needed)
- Sturdy book bag (type/wheels optional)
- package antibacterial wet wipes (not baby wipes)
- 1 roll paper towels

\*Different colored gel pens not allowed or needed.

4A only: 1 box large Zip-lock baggies

4B only: 1 package colored highlighters – thin size
