From Mrs. Enos - I would like to ask for your **help concerning the front parking lot** (student drop-off point) at the High School campus. It has been brought to my attention that after school some parents are parking their cars in the drop-off area for several minutes, which causes others to be blocked out of this area. This is causing a traffic back-up onto Morris Road. In addition, we have parents unable to pick up their students who are ready to leave for the day. Please be aware that you need to pull your car as far around the student pick-up circle as you can if you are waiting for your student.

Also, if your student is not out front ready to get into your car, we would ask that you not sit in front of the building for several minutes waiting on them. It will be necessary for you to park in the front parking lot and wait until your child is ready to leave for the afternoon, then you can pull into the circle to pick them up. Also, please remember we only want one lane of traffic in the front. A second lane of traffic is dangerous for students.

I am requesting that if you need to be out of your vehicle to pick up your student from after school care, go to a meeting in the school, or watch football practice - please park in the side parking lot closest to the chapel.

Thanks so much for your help in this matter. We want to be sure everyone is able to pick up their students in a safe and timely manner.
