



2021-2022 MINIMUM IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS K – 12TH GRADES

DTaP, DT (Pediatric) - Kindergarten: Four or more DTaP or DT or any combination. If all four doses were given before the fourth birthday, a fifth dose is required. If the fourth dose was administered at least six months after the third dose and on/or after the fourth birthday, a fifth dose is not required.

DTaP, DT (Pediatric) - 1st-12th grades: Four or more of DTaP or DT, or any combination. Three doses of Td or a combination of Td and Tdap is the minimum acceptable for children age seven and up.

Tdap - 7th-12th grades: One dose of Tdap vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

Polio - K-11th grades: Three or more doses of IPV. The final dose must be administered on or after the fourth birthday regardless of the number of previous doses. If a combination of OPV and IPV was received, four doses of either vaccine are required.

Polio - 12th grade: Three or more doses of IPV or OPV. If the third dose of either series was received prior to the fourth birthday, a fourth dose is required. If a combination of OPV and IPV was received, four doses of either vaccine are required.

MMR - K-12th grades: Two doses of MMR. Dose 1 must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after dose one.

Hepatitis B - K-12th grades: Three doses must be administered prior to entry.

Varicella Vaccine (Chicken Pox) - K-11th grades: Two doses of varicella vaccine must be administered prior to entry. Dose one must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose should be administered at least three months after dose one; however, if the second dose is administered at least 28 days after the first dose, it is considered valid.

Varicella Vaccine (Chicken Pox) - 12th grade: One dose of varicella must be administered on or after first birthday.

MCV4 (Meningococcal) - 7th-11th grades: One dose of meningococcal vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

MCV4 (Meningococcal) - 12th grade: Two doses of meningococcal vaccine must be administered prior to entry. If the first dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

NOTE: Students coming from outside of the United States will need a TB skin test.

A copy of your student's immunization record can be sent from your previous school, or your physician's office. If your previous school sends it, please remember you only have 15 days from the start of the school year to have it on file with CCS. Each dose of the vaccine should be denoted by complete month/day/year.
