



STUDENT ACTIVITY PERMISSION FORM

Throughout the school year, CCS has several annual campus-wide events requiring students to leave the Junior/Senior High Campus, or are dismissed early in the school day. This form alleviates the need to send home multiple permission slips during the year. Please read below to understand which events this would cover and sign at the bottom to indicate you have given permission for your child to participate in these school-wide events and early dismissal. **Please return this signed form with your back-to-school forms to the front office.**

ALL STUDENTS – GRADES 7-12

FALL PLAY: Students attend a CCS drama department performance at the Fairfield Community Arts Center during the School day. During the month of October, they are transported by bus to and from school for this one-day event.

SPRING PLAY: Students attend a CCS drama department performance at the Parrish Theater on the Miami Hamilton Campus during the school day. During the month of March, they are transported by bus to and from school for this one-day event.

EARLY DISMISSAL AFTER EXAMS: Semester exams take place in December and May from 8:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. for four days. Students are permitted to leave the first 3 days following exams with parental permission. A study hall is provided on the first 3 days of exams for the remainder of the afternoon should students need to remain on campus due to transportation conflicts. **PLEASE NOTE: All students will need to be picked up no later than 12:00 noon on day four of exams. NO study hall or after school care is provided on the last day of exams – it is an official half day of school.**

HOMECOMING AND PROM – GRADES 9-12

In signing this form, all senior high students and their parents signify they have read and understand the dance policies and guidelines listed below, set forth by Cincinnati Christian Schools, Inc.

1. Students must dance front to front at all times (no back to front).
2. Students will not dance in an inappropriate manner. No lewd, provocative or sexually suggestive dancing.
3. Students must keep their hands in appropriate places when placed on another student while dancing (i.e. shoulders, waist, back).
4. Students are not allowed to slam dance, mosh, or do any other form of dangerous dancing.
5. All guests are expected to abide by the same rules. CCS students are responsible for their guests that attend.
6. Any student leaving the venue early must notify a chaperone and sign out.

Chaperones will continually monitor the dance floor to ensure appropriate behavior. The chaperones reserve the right to deem anything inappropriate or require a student and/or a guest to be removed from the dance venue.

SPIRITUAL LIFE EMPHASIS WEEK (SLEW) 7-12

Some years during SLEW week, students may be taken off campus doing various team building activities and community service throughout the area. They would be transported by bus and chaperoned by CCS teachers.

SENIORS ONLY

SENIOR LUNCH: Each Friday during the school year, the seniors are permitted to leave campus for lunch during an extended lunch period. They provide their own transportation. Student drivers are required to complete a separate permission form and provide a copy of their driver's license and insurance card. **Senior Lunch is subject to cancellation at the discretion of the administration in the event of inclement weather or other emergencies on any given Friday.*

SENIOR FEAST: A long-standing CCS tradition, the seniors gather together on the Tuesday before Thanksgiving for a feast during an extended lunch period. Due to class size, this event takes place off campus at a local church fellowship hall. They are transported by bus to and from the church.
